
Career Cluster:





Employment Outlook

Based on the latest statistics, approximately 5 million people are employed in human services occupations. Faster than average employment growth through the year 2024, coupled with high turnover, should create numerous employment opportunities. Median annual wages for these occupations vary. For example, the median annual wage for shampooers is \$18,510, and the wage for industrial-organizational psychologists is \$80,330.

Business Information Management

Overview

Employees in the Business Information Management pathway deal with new applications of technology in the workplace, make strategic decisions and supervise individuals or teams in the use of these technologies to meet the business objectives of an organisation.

Employment Outlook

Employment for computer and information systems managers is expected to grow 15 percent over the next decade. Demand for computer and information systems managers will grow as firms increasingly expand their operations to digital platforms. Computer and information systems managers will be responsible for implementing these goals.


Credentials

Many positions in Business Information Management require a bachelor's degree in business administration, although employers seeking individuals for top-level positions often prefer a graduate degree, especially an MBA with technology as a core component. Degrees are also offered in library and information science. Some universities offer degrees in management information systems. These degrees blend technical subjects with business, accounting, and communications courses. A few computer and information systems managers attain their positions with only an associate or trade school degree, but they must have sufficient experience and must have acquired additional skills on the job. To aid their professional advancement, many managers with an associate degree eventually earn a bachelor's or master's degree while working. Professional organizations offer certification programs that are



Resume Builder

Located on the "About Me" tab, students can click on Resume to start building a printable resume. There are pull-down menus to select different parts of the resume like Objective, Work Experience, Education, etc. There are built in tips and suggestions to guide students to customize and complete a resume.

Scholarships & Enrichment Programs

Students can search for local and national scholarships that match their field of interest, major of study, location, gender, ethnicity, or grades, and more. Naviance also allows schools to maintain their own customized online scholarship database that students can use to track application deadlines and award statuses. Students can also explore various enrichment program opportunities in order to learn more about their intended major or enhance their college applications and resumes.



Can parents have a Naviance account?

We do not set up separate parent accounts but encourage parents to log on with their son or daughter to explore

➤ Where does Naviance pull data from to figure out student's GPA/test scores, and their admissions decisions (admitted, denied, etc.)

CHS uploads student's GPA electronically; also, we input a report of test scores from College Board. The admission decisions and reported outcomes (where students decide to attend) are all self-reported.
